It is recommended that an overflow pipe be buried to the edge of the river to keep the well box from filling with water. If the pressure is sufficient to supply the building one could put in a selector valve to select either "supply" or "overflow". If the pressure is not enough for building operation then a pump in the well would supply the building and the overflow would dump the excess into the river.
