

OTHER MINERAL OCCURRENCES:

SB & SEA

- Stratiform pyrite, pyrrhotite, minor chalcopyrite, sphalerite, galena
- not been evaluated because of subeconomic grades

MM/JJ

- Stratiform Barite-Pyrite +/- Sphalerite, Galena, Chalcopyrite
- Maximum thickness 9.4 m.
- Strike length at least 3750 m.

FLUKE

- Two thin (less than 2.5m thick) exposures of stratibound barite, pyrite, minor galena and sphalerite mineralization
- economic potential not adequately tested

ELF

- 22m thick zone of stratibound semi-massive and massive baritic/pyritic sulphides
- contains minor sphalerite and galena mineralization.
- strike length and width of mineralized zone unknown
- economic potential not adequately tested
