Subject: Pyrite "inclusion"

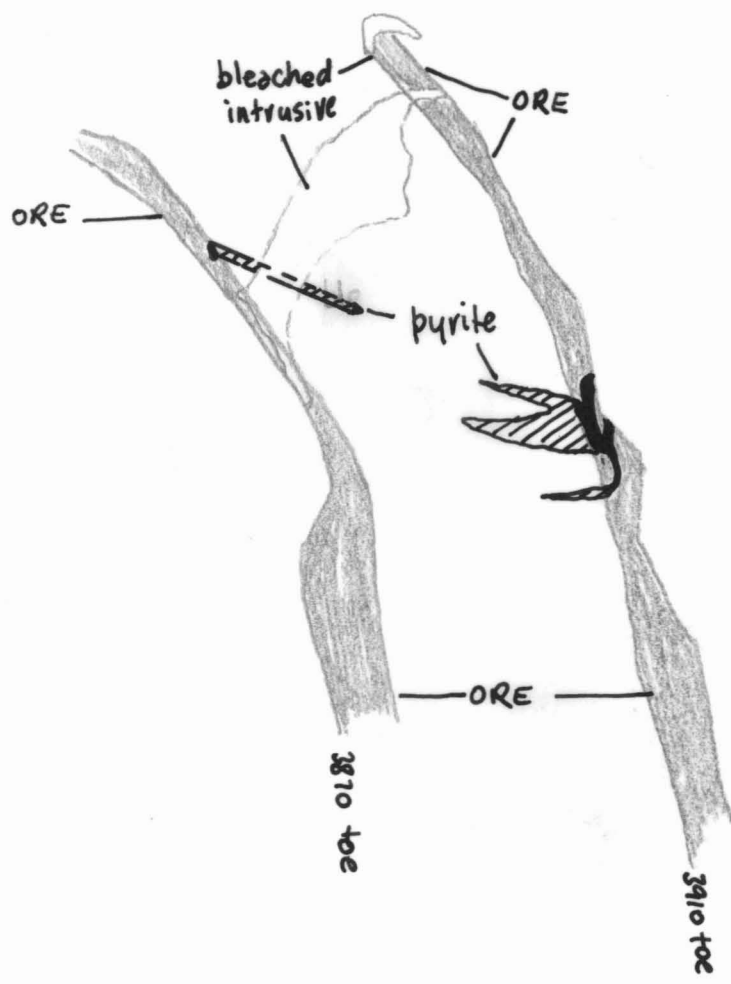

"Inclusion" seems to be generally somewhat concordant at all points with  $S_2$  layering in sulphides / quartzites. It seems to be plunging off to S.E. and around  $20^\circ$  and has been encountered in D.D.H. #70-4. This latter fact has already been taken into account in the bench plan revision of April-May 1972 (on the 2830 Bench).

In the 1972 development drilling #72-7 and #72-8 both encountered similar material. The former encountered 76' of it and the latter 23' of it. Assays from this material will be returning shortly and further consideration will be given to it at that time. The ore concerned is well outside the present pit development.

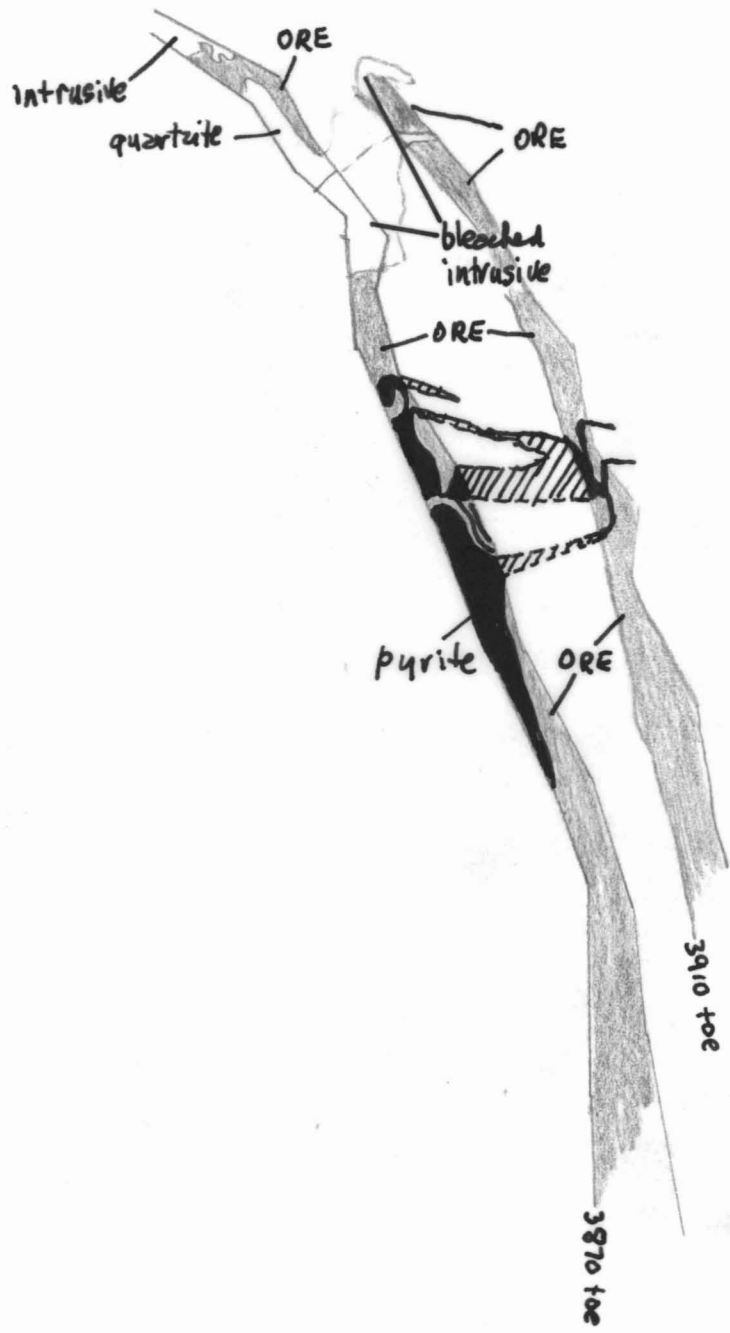

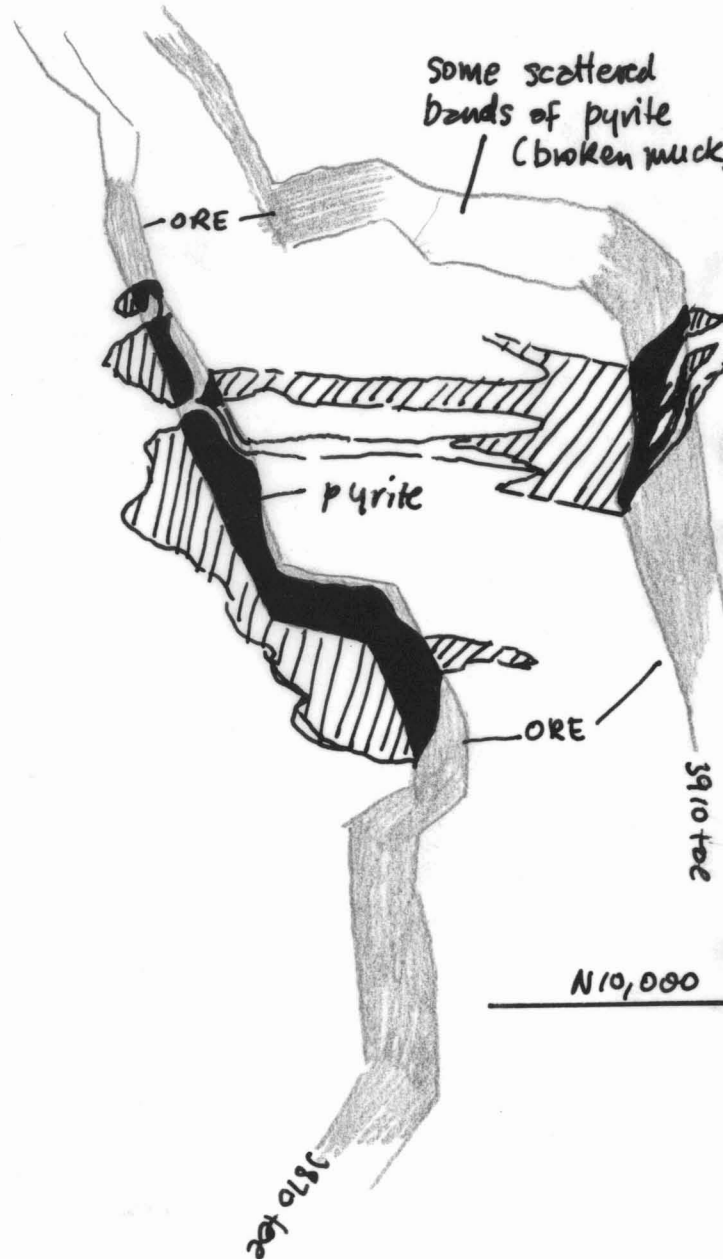
