SUBJECT: ORE CONTROL SIGNALS

Shovel operators should give the signal designating the type of ore he has loaded on to a truck.

The Foreman should inform the truck drivers whether they are to haul to the crusher or stockpile.

Confusion arises when low grade is scheduled to be hauled to the crusher and the shovel operator uses the high grade signal - if the crusher has stopped taking ore, the load is likely to be delivered to the high grade stockpile.
