## Notes:

1. South end of 3870 has not met expectations (a loss of around 10,000 tons) and a 22' face was not achieved. Instead, it appears that a 7' - 8' face was mucked.
2. Around 3,000 tons of 7% 3990 ore could theoretically be blended with the 12% 3990 ore to give 15,000 tons of 11% ore. This could give us 35,000 tons of 11% ore from 3990 during the rest of the month.
3. At present, the amount of 3950 ore to be mucked is not known with any certainty.
