SUBJECT: 1965-1971 CORE RESAMPLING PROGRAMME DATE: May 10, 1973

Some time ago the writer suggested that reject samples from pre-1972 DDH core be rebagged and properly catalogued for future reference. This project has proved to be monumental because of the vast number of samples (around 9,000) and the severe deterioration of the paper bags used for many of the samples.

It is now suggested that we retain all samples from holes lying in the following (Zone 1 and 3) cross-sections:

1. Section 22
2. Section 104
3. Section 112
4. Section 120
5. Section 128

These holes, together with samples from 1972 and future diamond drilling, will provide a permanent record of some of the most significant features of the ore body.

1973 DDH's will provide more than adequate coverage of Zone 2.
