SUBJECT: DIAMOND DRILLING FOR 1973

The proposed drilling requirement for 1973 is 5,750 feet, at an estimated cost of \$57,500.

Drilling is required in three areas as follows:

- AREA 1 Hole numbers 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7 totalling 3,200 ft. are required to more precisely define the limits of the ore zone on the east and west sides of the mine in the 1973 - 1977 mining areas. This information is required at this time to be able to design the mine slope which we must begin to establish during the next couple of years. These holes also fill in on the 150' x 150' grid for ore grade control.
- AREA 2 Hole number 8, 500 feet long, is required to fill in on a 150' x 150' grid for ore grade control in 1974.
- AREA 3 Hole numbers 9, 10 and 11 totalling 2,050 ft. are required to fill in on a 300' x 300' grid in an area to be mined during 1975, 76 and 1977. These are necessary to be able to more accurately forecast ore grade and quantity and all material mining quantities for equipment evaluations.

Estimated cost is based upon 1972 history which was \$9.00 per foot on a \$60,000 program.

\$10.00 per foot is estimated for 1973 to allow for a general increase and contingencies. Therefore total estimated cost is 5,750 ft. at \$10/ft = \$57,500.

An attached plan indicates the location of these holes.
