Subject: DIAMOND DRILLING

The following is the plan for phasing out the drilling on FARO.

1. Shut down machine on No 2 Zone on completion of current hole.
2. Leave machine at site in No 2 Zone.
3. Finish hole on No 3 Zone (67-30) and demobilize that machine.
4. Resume drilling on No 2 Zone after discontinuing on No 3 Zone.  
(One machine two shifts)

After the first shut down of the machine on No 2 zone, you will have an excess of crew from which Arsenault Diamond Drilling can select suitable crews to continue on the Faro and Rich jobs.
