Subject 1976 Faro Drilling Program

Further to our discussion this afternoon, I propose we modify the Faro drilling program as follows:

1. Delete drilling on Section 106 because of site location problems.
2. Collar DDHX76-09 on Section 118 at the following co-ordinates, N10,118, E15,285. Proposed depth 2,400' (NQ to 1,000', BQ to EOH), or as required.
3. Collar DDHX76-10 at one of the following sites listed in order of priority as mining operations permit:

<u>Priority</u>	<u>Location</u>	<u>Co-ordinates</u>	<u>Proposed Depth</u>
1	Section 110	N10,335; E13,950	700'
2	Section 118	N 9,820; E14,985	800'
3	Section 118	N 9,702; E14,908	800'
4	Section 110	N10,210; E13,810	500'
5	Section 118	N 9,230; E14,320	900'
6	Section 110	N10,000; E13,600	500'

Not all sites need be drilled, e.g. if DDH at N9,820; E14,985 is completed, N9,702; E14,908 will not have to be drilled and vice versa. All remaining sites should be drilled, i.e. a total footage of approximately 5,800' should be drilled (including the 2,400' hole) to effect a reconnaissance symmetry test on two stations.

This information is being telexed to Stan Buziak at Faro. The relevant holes with priority ranking are indicated on your 400 scale drill plan.


