THROUGH ZONE 3

Further to our discussions of recent days, I propose a 1500-2000 foot bore hole at the intersection of Sections 1<sup>23</sup> to 5 and 21, per attached 400 scale map. This location is approximate and subject to revision, etc. by the powers that be, but generally in this area or at the intersection of "fill-in" cross sections.

It seems most logical to use Caron Diamond Drilling to complete this hole since it leaves our 38 free for drilling elsewhere. In addition, Caron's contract price of \$12-13 per foot is better than the contract we have with Arctic.

If Engineering will foot the bill from collar to 50 feet below massive sulfides, Exploration will carry costs to the end of the hole. If this proposal meets with your collective approval, please notify me, J. G. Simpson, or U. Jansons, not necessarily in that order.
