Dear Murray:

I received the map tube of geochemical maps and have reviewed them in only cursory fashion. However, I've nothing profound to offer from a geochemical standpoint on any of those properties so far. I'll take a deeper look later on once we've had related geophysical surveys completed.

Can you have Dave Mayes send me a rough geological section across the Faro to the Pelly as we discussed when I saw you last? Also can he send me a four mile topographic map showing exactly where he has chosen to develop his remaining sections in the district? Once I have a look at the Faro section that he has hopefully developed by now, it will give me a chance to critically guide the development of his remaining sections. Those will be the ones that we would hope to localize an area or areas to do detailed airborne geophysical studies on as well as perhaps geochemistry.

Also, can you let me know, by appropriate coordinates on the LEE geochemical map which I have, where you decided to spot that LEE drill hole and your estimated depth of penetration?

Finally, can you let me know also by appropriate coordinates on the FARO geochemical map, when you decided to spot that gravity-IP based drill hole north of the Faro No. 1 zone? You'll have to give that some deep thought in view of the apparent displacement of the IP anomaly from the gravity. Please review the Faro No. 1 IP in conjunction with this. If you'll recall the Faro No. 1 IP anomaly was displaced to the north, presumably as a result of the south dip on the orebody. It may be that a comparable appraisal on this other situation will suggest that a possible orebody dips to the north instead.

Let me know when you would like me to next visit up there. I have a major project shaping up in Yellowknife for a good part of October so let me know when is best from your standpoint.
