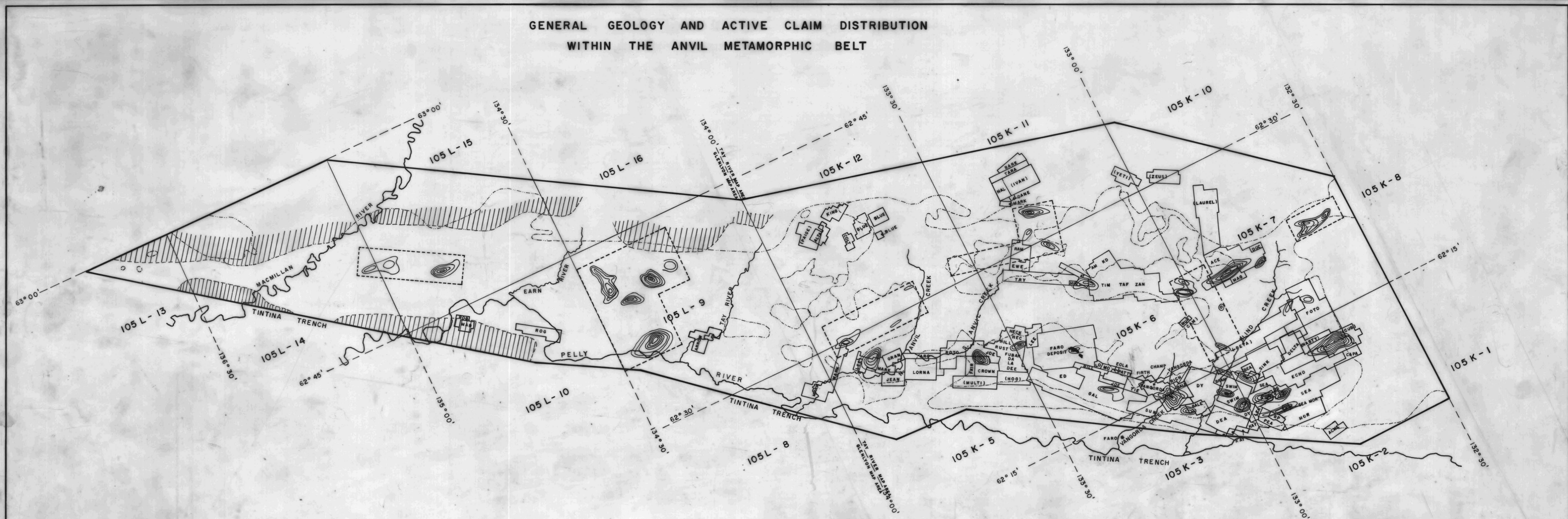


GENERAL GEOLOGY AND ACTIVE CLAIM DISTRIBUTION
WITHIN THE ANVIL METAMORPHIC BELT

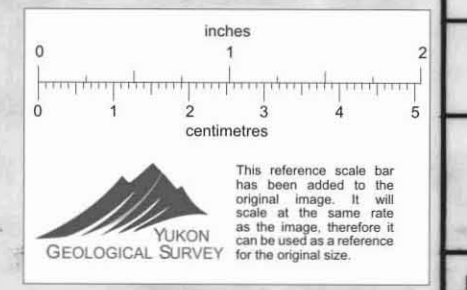
