SUBJECT: ORE IN SAFETY BERM

A row of blastholes, consisting of 10-52 foot deep holes were drilled between section 122 + 070 and 124 +000, outside the west dig limit of the south phase. The holes were drilled from the 3490 elevation to the 3438 elevation. They were logged carefully and assayed on two 20' intervals. The results of these assays show that approximately 11,000 tonnes grading 8.96% Pb + Zn exist in the 3470 bench and 2,000 tonnes grading 7.1% in the 3490 bench.

It was decided, by Dino Basso, that the holes would not be blasted due to the need for a safety perm, (required by mines inspector), on the 3470 bench. This ore will therefore remain in situ as part of the safety berm.
