MEMORANDUM

RE: Copper King - Carlisle Drilling

The pendant which contains the Copper King and Carlisle Mines has a strike length of 1,400' and a width of 800'. Small shipments of high grade ore were shipped from the mines in the early 1900's, prior to 1910.

Four holes aggregating 1,021' were drilled in the vicinity of the Copper King Mine in 1964. Holes 3 and 4, which intersected narrow sections of high grade ore, are shown on the attached sketch.

A 1,200' hole is proposed to test for mineralization under the old workings, or below the mineralization intersected in KK 3. A second hole 400' east on strike is contingent on results.
