Maps

In order to help you keep the maps organized so that you can return them in the same order as they went out, I've included a little chart of the maps we are lending you.

The small roll covers mostly property scale stuff. It includes a very important grid map- this is the only copy, do not loose it-, a claim map, a property geology map (all at 1" to 1/2 mile) as well as two detailed topo maps of the north part of the property, one showing the location of EM-16 anomalies.

The maps are organized from north to south, and are categorized according to either the name of the grid or the main deposit/s in their respective area. One roll consists of geology maps, the other contains geochem/mag and DDH Information. It will take me a while to sort through the IP, so let me know if you need it. We didn't find it that useful as there were so many different surveys, and mag seems to be what worked best. So I'll wait until I hear from you before organizing all that data.
