

Al Carlos - I called him Aug 17/78

New showing is o/c in creek @ 112W along their BL # 500' north. Bulldozed last year & didn't see it - this year found - only 2' square - o/c looks gneissic but has chlorite phyllite - also Mn carbonate? (it's along the creek (fault?))
Mixed Pb & Zn but more Zn than Pb. Haven't seen graphite, but not much rock around.

Caches & Harris are going to drill the Dupont ground new for a few weeks. They are going to probably option Shale group, but not right away - Jürgen Jan is on holidays & they have filed 3 years assessment. Copies of Shale drill logs are coming down but o/c depths were only 12', 19', 45' (in 60' hole) etc - not bad.

Dupont ground is high Zn, poor Pb, no graphite visible, green chloritic phyllite fragments in soils, limonite staining, with quartz.
