Cam and I are creating three different drawings for the GRUM G9110 model:

- 1) Bench plan BXXMDL.DWG 1:1,000
  - block model with rock code, %Pb+Zn, g/t Ag
  - underground workings in thickness of the bench
  - overburden bedrock contour at mid-bench level
  - surface topography at mid-bench level
  - I.V. Stage 1, 2 and 3 pits at mid-bench level
  - location of drillhole bench composites in the thickness of the bench.
  - block rows and columns
  - cross and long section locations
  
- 2) Bench plan BXXGEOL.DWG 1:1,000
  - geological contacts at mid-bench level
  - faults at mid-bench level
  - underground workings in thickness of the bench
  - overburden bedrock contact at mid-bench level
  - surface topography at mid-bench level
  - drillhole bench composites in the thickness of the bench. Ore composites are labelled with hole-id, %Pb+Zn, rock type
  - ore types are indicated with different pattern shading
  - limit of geological interpretation
  - I.V. Stage 1, 2 and 3 pits at mid-bench level
  - cross and long sections locations
  
- 3) Cross Section 1:500
  - projected drillhole trace
  - surface topography
  - overburden bedrock surface

- underground workings in plane of the section
- geological contacts
- faults
- lithologic units down the hole
- geologic composites down the hole (2m long)
- I.V. Stage 1, 2 and 3 pits profiles
- bench elevation levels
- long section locations
- shading of the different ore types

Enclosed are examples of the three plots. Cross section information displayed are still in flux. Please let us know soon if there is any information which you would like to see included or deleted from these drawings.
