Dear Mr. Rennick:

I am enclosing the various items that you requested in our recent telephone conversation.

The table lists the measured downhole deviations for the four drill holes surveyed by White Geophysical.

One paper copy and one sepia mylar copy of the requested maps have been included. On the paper copies I have circled the locations of the surveyed drill holes. In addition I have coloured in the new surface extent of the 10E dyke immediately northwest of the Faro open pit. This modification in the size of the dyke is required by the results of drill holes 89FX-02 and 89FX-04.
