Dick Janes who heads the Husky Oils Mineral section in Calgary, advised me that the Husky Oil people are getting out of mineral exploration and he handed me a summary of what they have done to date and are willing to present us with more data if we are interested in probably entering an agreement.

Some of the properties lie outside my area in the Yukon and B.C. I would suggest the Foster River Zinc properties look interesting but Husky Oil and Candell Oil will hold a meeting with Eric Partridge to decide a deal if we decide to proceed further into studying this property. Apparently the nature of the agreement with Partridge calls for this arrangement. Janes suggested this property especially the Sito east showing was worth more follow-up. He also suggested further work on the Mink Zinc prospect.

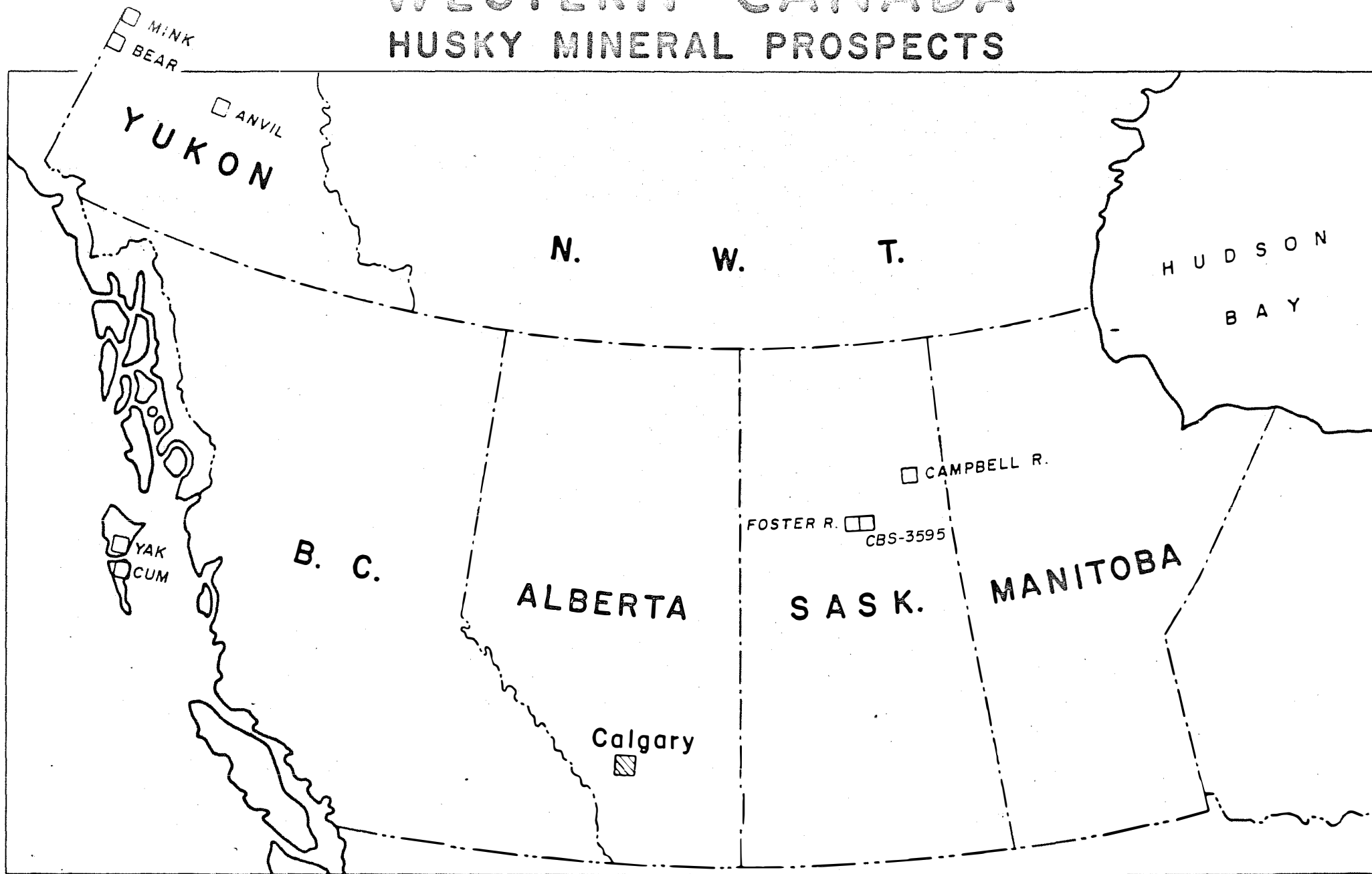

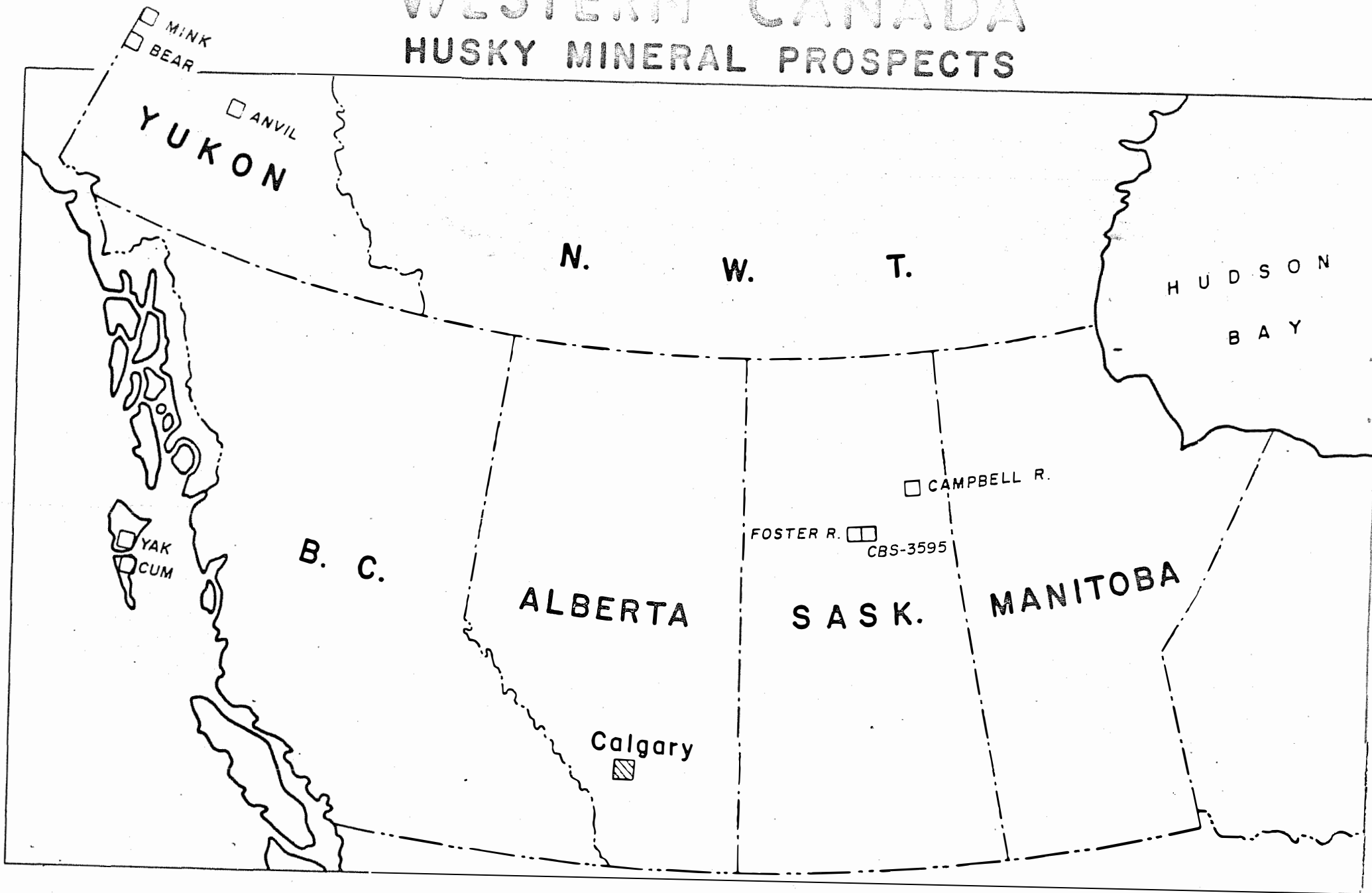

GEOLOGICAL SUMMARY:

Mineralization is located in Permo-Penn. Ettran Formation, a carbonate sequence. It is composed of: 1) a minor amount of sphalerite with exsolved chalcopyrite which is scattered throughout a silicified shatter zone, and 2) irregular rounded masses, up to 12 inches in diameter, of smithsonite which occur in bedded limestone. The extent of the smithsonite occurrence is not known, it may be 200 ft. by 500 ft.
