

Yukon Mineral Industry 1941-1959

Chapter 12 1951; Mac Group (8) & Carbon Group (22)

- high grade Stibnite, east slope Carbon Hill,
- discovered early 1900's, old tunnel reopened 1951 (westerly direction)

High Grade: 47.67% Sb; 0.04% As low Grade 11.18% Sb, 0.04% As

Empire Group (14)

- NW slope Carbon Hill, surface showings, continuation of Mac & Carbon

- surface; high as 49.20% Sb, 0.07% As

→ on W side of hill 12.59% Sb, 0.11% As

- these showings parallel high grade deposits on Empire

& Porter Group on NW side of Carbon Hill

Chief Group (4)

- Sb/Ag, Chieftain Gulch deposit discovered ~1900

Nesjack & Winnie Groups (6)

- cover Gold Union Mines property on Idaho Hill W of Annie Lake, adit on E face of hill

Chapter 13 1951

Yukon Exploration & Development Company Limited

- acquired 19 claims on Sb showing on Carbon Hill

Chapter 16 1955

- much staking on both shores of Bennet Lake in Tes

Chapter 18 1957

Charleston Claim - head of Watson River, originally 1906

W.E. Cockfield reported 1922

- extensive vein, metal values erratic & generally low
