Dear Bill

The 'cat' is still digging on the same trench. He is down about 12' and I think we should have bed rock exposed by this afternoon. So far the rock fragments consist mainly of pyritic sericite schist with some graphite schist. The pyritic rock is leached, the cube cavities indicating the transported and lost Fe. I will have to assume that this is the cause of the gossan. I will bring ^{or send} samples.

I will go into "Fog" Lake with Andrews as soon as this is cleaned up and then ~~out~~ on to Vargorda and the Pelly R. if no further instructions are forthcoming from you.
