Sirola reported by phone they have picked up a 450 millivolt self-potential anomaly 2000 feet in length which strikes N60W and is open to the north west. The gossan areas are subparallel to the anomaly. There are no associated magnetics so pyrrhotite is not likely and base metals are unlikely on the geochemical evidence. He suspects pyrite possibly in graphitic schist. The gossan is being stripped with a "cat" and samples will then be taken to assay for gold and silver and possibly spectrographically. If the showing is only pyrite no work other than sampling is proposed.

Sirola asked about the agreement. Frank Teney advises it will be ready for you on Tuesday September 4th. Sirola is returning to Vancouver today.
