

*Carcross Area, Yukon.*

Charlie Brown of White Pass & Yukon has a voluminous file on this property which used to be called the "Big Thing". The property is located 7 miles south of Carcross. The gold values occur in a flat quartz vein cutting granodiorite. Extensive underground work was done on this property by the British Yukon Gold Mining Company from 1908-1916. The underground maps show that the vein has a 20° dip, and that the ore occurs only in very small, widely scattered pockets, some of which are fairly high grade (1 oz. plus). The amount of stoping compared to development was negligible. Presumably the current work is being done on one of these high grade pockets.

It is difficult for me to become excited about the prospects of making a large gold mine out of this situation in view of the information I have just reviewed, but ~~we~~ we will try to keep an open mind on the subject.
