Enclosed find examination report by J. M. Baker of Cox antimony prospect recently staked by our men. Present antimony prices are low, but have seen wide price fluctuation over recent years. We are obtaining more information on possible buyers etc.

After reading the enclosed report, would you submit your own assessment of the prospect with respect to transportation, EM survey drilling, and layout of addit to develop the main showing.

We have not yet received a staking sketch of the Carbon Hill group of 20 claims covering the prospect. These sketches should be forwarded as soon as possible after recording for Ted Jacka's files.
