Attached is a copy of a letter I have written to Mike Chefkoi in answer to one received by him in which he said he would like to submit some samples from something he reports he ran across after freeze-up this year.

As you probably realize Chefkoi, known in the Dawson City area as "Montreal Mike", lives with Ole and Donna Metby out in the Glacier Creek area off the road to Alaska from Dawson City. You may well have met him when you went to look at that reported lead situation. I remember you telling me afterwards that it turned out to be held by Metby and to be the same thing I looked at several years ago.

I don't have very much hope that whatever Chefkoi reports he has turned up recently will amount to very much, but I consider it just as well for you to receive whatever samples he wants to submit, so that you can have a look at them and have one or more assayed.
