Dear Glen:

The joint venture program in the Yukon is going smoothly and I would like to pass on a brief summary of the work to date. All of the claim groups staked last year have been geologically mapped, geochemically sampled and evaluated. Briefly, the results from the groups are as follows:

a) Windy, Jeanette, Yogi, Yuk and Ken

No further work recommended. ✓

b) Jane Claims

The source of the anomalies is a series of springs which reach surface along the limonite-stained creek. The anomaly does not appear to be caused by the shales nor by limonite-scavenging. Further geochemical work and rock-chip assaying is warranted to determine the source of the anomaly. ✓

c) Bev Claims

A broad soil anomaly with values in lead up to 1000 ppm and zinc up to 3000 ppm is open along contour and up-slope. A piece of float located in one creek assayed 8% zinc. Examination of the scarce outcrops and rock in two test pits have not located any obvious source of the anomaly. Rock-chip assaying and further soil sampling are being carried out. ✓

Reconnaissance sampling is progressing well despite a late start due to late snow break-up. Three claim groups have been staked and are reported on below:

a) Slats Creek

No further work recommended.


b) Laura and BUH Claims

These two groups are located in the same area (133000', 65005') and are considered geologically similar. Zinc mineralization has been located in an outcrop of collapse breccia material on the BUH. A positive zinc spot test over a distance of at least 200 feet has been located on Laura claims. However, no primary mineralization can be seen. Mapping, prospecting and sampling are continuing. ✓

I hope this provides you with a feeling for the work to date. I am looking forward to having Bill make a trip up if he can find the time.
