Dear Mike:

Thank you for the report on the 1974 joint venture. A couple of very good leads may have been picked up, especially on the BEV group.

I note that in the map file submitted, we did not get a copy of the plan showing distribution of the Sekwi and Bear Rock (Cambrian) units. You had a copy of this when we visited you in Calgary, but it is probably a "work sheet" category and was not included in the report. I would like to have a copy for reference, though, and will promise not to consider it as anything but preliminary.

I have been thinking about Norm's reference to the spatial relationship of mineralization to stream location. That is, it seems that we get significant mineralization on one side of a stream valley and not on the other. The inference is that the stream location is dictated by the position of the reefal front, with the fore-reef area being more susceptible to erosion. Whether this resistant quality of the reef itself is caused by inherent qualities of the rock or by incipient alteration related to mineralization is a matter of speculation. However, surely the same effect should be apparent in the vertical sense, and a mineralized area should be capped by a relative topographic high. Your photo of the Goz Creek prospect in the report suggests this possibility.

Following this matter through to its ultimate ridiculous conclusion, we should then take great care with the BEV group in particular. If the rocks

are right, we may be looking at a topographic high which defines the axis of a mineralized trend.
