RE: SW YUKON GEOCHEMICAL STREAM SEDIMENT SAMPLES

During 1970-71, Canadian Occidental Petroleum Ltd. completed a reconnaissance geochemical stream sediment survey in a 25,000 - sq.mi. area in southwestern Yukon (see the attached map). A total of some 13,000 samples were collected and all samples were analysed for Cu, Zn, Mo and U. About 2,000 samples were also analysed for Ag. To date none of these samples has been analysed for Au.

- 80 mesh fraction of all these samples are currently in our storage in Toronto. Mylar copies of sample locations maps (drainage maps at a scale of 1 : 50,000) are available. Canadian Oxy would like to sell the samples and the maps for a fraction of the original total field costs.

If you are currently exploring for low grade, high tonnage gold deposits in this part of Yukon and are planning to carry out regional geochemical surveys to outline areas anomalous in gold the above material could help in reducing your field costs considerably.

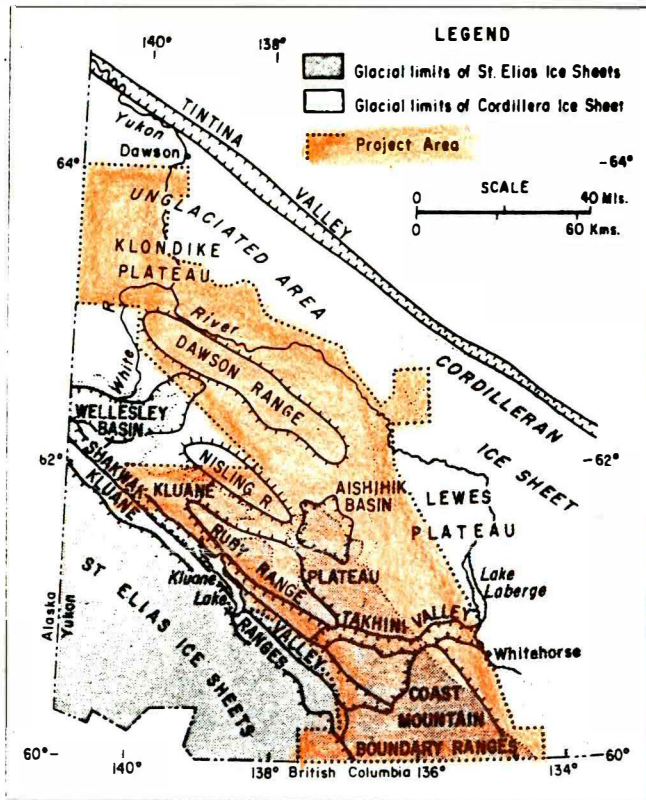
