LOCATION

Near Kluane Lake, Yukon Territory.

GEOLOGY

1. Host tuffs just below a peridotite sill  
5 m of 0.30 ounces per ton (best intersection).
2. A cherty pyritic tuff host in the west part of  
the property (Johnson Creek). 0.796 ounces per  
ton Au over 1-34 m.

Tuff unit is +30 m thick but mineralization is  
erratic in grade and width.

CLAIMS

303 Claims (Whitehorse mining district) staked in  
1978, '80, '81, '82, '83, '84.

RECOMMENDATION AND CONCLUSION

The mineralization is erratic and may be related to  
vertical faulting in addition to its favoured host position in  
tuff below a peridotite sill.

No further action is warranted at this time.
