

Extract from situation Report dated June 24th, 1956 written by E. O. Chisholm

J 3/7a

Quill Creek Area.

Teck-Hughes are drilling two claims from our northwest boundary on Arch Creek. I have tried to make arrangements for Morisette to drill our ground on the completion of the work but no word has been received from their office yet. If word is not received soon we will have to arrange a contract with Boyles, as the optim time for this work is sometime in July. Dr. Frohberg advises that he is unable to ge a hole on his copper-zinc float showing on Jarvis Creek due to heavy overburden. The future of this ground does not appear to be hopeful at this range.

Hudson Bay Mining & Smelting are still driving underground at the Hudson Yukon property. It is understood they have made minor additons of high grade ore, this year. Another drill is at work on surface exposures at Quill Creek valley approximately two miles south of the main show.
