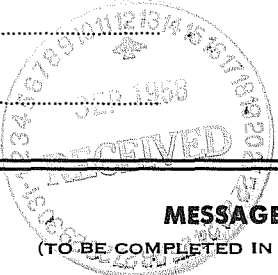

SUBJECT gold prospect - Ross
River area - Y.T.



MESSAGE

Dear Sir:

The following is the information I have been able to uncover on the matter of the gold find that you mentioned in Tuesdays telephone conversation.

Fred Hasselberg, prospector employed by Newmont Mining Corp, has been prospecting in the general area of Wilson Lake and Keele Peak since last May when he was placed in the area on Skis prior to break-up. The area is generally the east side of the Sheldon Map sheet and the west side of the Nahanni Map sheet in the Wilson - John Lakes area. Coord. are about 130-00: 62-50.

From Don Cannon, Field Engineer for Newmont, I have the following information:

In mid-August, Hasselberg found a shear zone in quartzites and slates, mineralized heavily with arsenopyrite which he traced for 900 feet horizontally and a distance of 500 ft vertically. The shear strikes 325 Az and dips steeply cutting the ~~estimated~~ bedding of the quartzites which dips flat at minus 20 deg. Widths uncovered vary from 4 ft at one end to 20 ft in the widest portion, tho Cannon thinks it will have an average width of better than ten ft.

Hasselberg sampled two exposures, across four feet (the showing had not been traced for its 900 ft length) and the best sample assayed 1.7 oz Au, tr Ag, and 0.10 Cu.

Since that date some 16 samples, chips, across the shear for the full length have been assayed. I saw the assay plan and none of the samples assayed over 0.25 ozs, the silver and copper values being uninteresting.

The claim group staked on this showing is named the Black group. Cannon has had a ~~mark~~ on the site but has not commenced any serious programme of stripping and trenching.

The location, which I am unable to verify at present is approx 100 miles NE of Ross Post and some 15 miles S.E of the Canol Rd - the latter being impassable beyond Ross Post

Other than this find, we are unable to find any record of staking in the Ross River area. These claims are not recorded as yet.

Bill Hare who was at the Lapie Canyon recently reported new claim posts on the Canol Rd but I do not believe that is the site of the report you have.
