

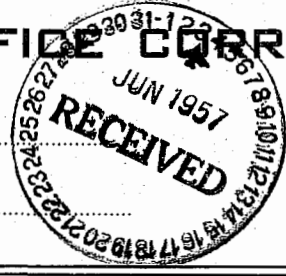

Attached is a map of the Mt Haldane area (105 M) index area showing the claims staked on the area over the geo-chemical highs recorded by the GSC mapping effort.

McIntyre, recorder at Mayo thinks Pack and O'Neill and Pack engineered the deal: i.e. they own the claims tho registration of transfer has not been recorded. They are one or both employees of United Keno Hill.

No work has been done on the claims, there was snow there last week when i stopped over for the day.

Think this staking would not justify a trip except we have other things of inter est in the area, and unless you advise otherwise will not contact the claim owners unless I have work in the area.
