This is with reference to your letter from Kulan dated December 1st a copy of which you made for me in Vancouver.

I wish to confirm our verbal understanding that we do not want to do anything with this Alberta group.

Concerning Strebchuck's desire to become a Kerr prospector, I think that in addition to advising Al Kulan that we do not want to take any interest in the Alberta group you advise Al that we can only keep Strebchuck in mind for possible employment as a prospector next field season. When we have a look at Strebchuck's reported 12 foot wide galena vein we should acquire a pretty good idea of his reliability as an intelligent prospector. Although I have no doubt as to Strebchuck's earnestness, I was rather disappointed by the "mineralized zone" on his Alberta group.

You can send Al the attached copy of this memorandum if you wish.

Dear Bill:

Enclosed are the results of an Electrical Resistivity survey by Mr. Clark on the Alberta Group held by John Strebchuck.

Mr. Strebchuck is willing to give Kerr a 30 day free option if Kerr would drill the anomalies with a pack sack drill or do a stripping job. If this work would uncover anything of interest this property could be purchased for seventy five thousand with a low down payment.

When you are through with this report please return it as I have to send it back to Strebchuck.

John Strebchuck has offered Kerr a deal which is as follows:

If Kerr would employ him as a prospector for the next 12 months at 450.00 per month for the summer months and 200.00 per month for the Winter he is willing to turn over the Moon group of 4 claims and disclose 4 other prospects to Kerr for a ten percent stock interest in any company that might be formed on any of these properties. In talking to the local Mayo residents John is an average prospector and a hard worker.

In reply to your memo of November 10th on this subject, it is definitely my recollection that the property was first mentioned by Angus MacDonald while we were examining the Peso Silver Property.

Angus has been in fairly close touch with Strebchuck regarding this property and his last advice to me was on October 17th when he mentioned that Strebchuck was about to do the necessary staking. It did not seem feasible for me to go with Strebchuck at that time because Strebchuck had advised that there was 2' of snow on the ground. Perhaps it has melted since then as Kulan intends to investigate the showings.

I have kept in touch with the Peso situation through the George Cross Newsletters, and through telephone conversations with Aho, but gather that while other veins have been exposed, no values of consequence have been found. The Peso people intend to drive the adit themselves.

Attached are the scratch pad page of notes and the Keno Hill - Sourdough Hill area map which you left with me when you were here.

Of the various properties listed the most virgin apparently is the 16 claim group which Strebchuk is reported to have staked after Christmas over his advertised 12 foot thick solid galena vein which Angus first told us about when we were on the Peso property early last fall. Concerning that property I want you to do as follows: yourself or Angus write to Strebchuk indicating a definite interest on our part and stating that as a first step on our part we would want Al Kulan to examine the showing. Also determine from Strebchuk if you can, his present thoughts on what deal he wants.

Concerning the Alberta and Vanguard groups which Angus says he can deal, you should accumulate all possible information and data concerning them including the terms of the deals desired; then make your recommendations.

Concerning the 64 to 88 claims Angus can deal located on 3 sides of Peso Silver, I suggest that our best approach is to keep in close touch with Peso progress. Do you know the deal wanted for the claims? I imagine there is some known mineralized float on them. What is the extent of the known ^{mineralization} evidence of interest on the claims?

Angus advised yesterday that Strebchuck managed to stake the Galena Prospect early in the year. Apparently, Strebchuck acquired 16 claims. I see no reason why Kulan could not visit the property when conditions permit, but some other Group has been negotiating with Strebchuck and their arrangement with him is that if they like the ground, they will make an immediate undisclosed cash payment.

Strebchuck apparently had some grab samples assayed and these ran from 30 - 32 ozs. of silver. The ground has been held before, but we do not know how much work was done thereon. To the best of Angus's knowledge, there are 9 showings of galena but he does not have any idea at this stage whether or not these showings are commercially significant.

Upon being informed by Kulan that he considered he should go in and help John Strebchuck stake the above prospect so that we can have a good look at it in the spring, I phoned Kulan today and advised him to proceed. The intention is for Kulan to have a close look at the exposed showings and to determine whether they are sufficiently interesting for us to tie up until next spring the central claims Strebchuck will stake in his own name. Strebchuck apparently would want a \$500 down payment in order to give us first refusal until the spring. If Kulan likes the prospect he intends to stake adjoining claims for Kerr. Also if he considers the prospect of considerable immediate interest he may arrange for a bulldozer to open up the thing now.

It is my memory that this reported 12 foot vein prospect of Strebchuck's was first brought to our attention by Angus MacDonald when we were on the Peso property. I wish that you would let me know whether or not this is also your memory on the matter.

While Kulan is in the Mayo area I have advised him to try to have another visit to the Peso property to bring our information up to date on developments there. Peso, judging by reports one hears appears to be finding additional veins of interest on its property, and I consider that we should continue to maintain very close contact with their developments. Mr. Walker arranged for Aho's latest reports and maps to be submitted to me, and after I have studied the data I will forward all of it to you.

Angus MacDonald advised yesterday that on, or about, the 16th of this month, John Strebchuck will stake the 12' wide Galena showing that he mentioned while we were examining the Peso Silver property. Whether or not we will get to this property this Fall depends on snow conditions.

Angus advises that Strebchuck delayed staking because there is an access road which is passable by a four-wheel drive vehicle after the ground freezes. This road will get John within four miles of the showing.

Whatever happens, we will make every effort to tie this ground up until such time as we can get to it. It has been implied by Strebchuck that not only does this vein have a considerable width, but also some considerable length.
