

Notes on SRK report September 1986

- 1 Report assumes that it is better implement as much of the abandonment plan prior to closure as opposed to after. Is this our position in general? We may be better off allowing the sinking fund build-up over 20 years to pay for the abandonment plan as opposed to diverting resources to abandonment during the life of the mine.
- 2 Report continually makes reference to the currently licensed abandonment plan, i.e. Scheme 2 K.L. This plan is no longer part of our licence.
