THE VARIATION OF THE COMPASS NEEDLE, JANUARY, 1922

The variation of the compass needle at any place, at any time, is the variation given on that date. At other dates the variation is between 1/2° more or less than that on the given date. It increases 1/2° in a year between the two red lines marked 1917 and 1922; the variation is 5° east of true north at Teslin, and 5° west of true north at Dawson.
