

MEMORANDUM RE ROADS IN THE YUKON

Mr. Ken Christie of the Department of Mines, Ottawa, came in to see me today having heard that we are considering bringing Vangorda Mines into production. I explained the situation and the current interests of three Japanese firms but primarily Mitsui, to him. I told him that if the Japanese would give us an iron-clad firm price contract for the concentrates, we might decide to bring the property to production.

He told me that the Ross River to Carmacks Road has for the time being been wiped off their construction programme for the next three or four years, and I understand that this is probably in favour of relocating the Canol Road from Ross River to Norman Wells. He said that construction programmes for 1965 will have to be firm by the middle of June this year and that it is very important if we are going to want the road through to Carmacks that they be advised at the earliest possible date.
