Verne Davidson of Commonwealth Construction was in this office October 6, 1975. Commonwealth is in a 60-40 deal with Reserve Oil and Gas (40% Commonwealth) on several properties. He wanted to bring two in the Mayo area of the Yukon to our attention in particular. Note that these companies operate the Silver Springs copper properties in the Iron Bridge area of Ontario.

Jim McDermott, ex-president of Commonwealth, lives in Vancouver (681-2554), and guides the mineral exploration end of Commonwealth. He has the data on the Mayo properties, and I have instructed Bill Sirola to contact him and have a look.

On the attached plans, which Davidson left with me, there are two groups indicated. Both are high grade Pb-Zn-Ag vein types accessible by road from Mayo.


PADDY-CAROL CLAIMS:

26 claims, seven miles NE of United Keno, Y.T. Adit with development presently going on. Five veins of narrow width. Development heading sample as example gives 24.5% Pb, 14.00% Zn, 38.4 oz. Ag over 2.9 feet.

LUCKNOW CLAIMS:

Approximately 150 claims held to north of Paddy-Carol group. Several veins known but best of them, exposed only on surface, has been traced over 1,000 feet at a 3- to 12-foot width. Lead, zinc, and silver content is very high.

Verne Davidson suggested we visit the properties; this will be contingent on W. Sirola's recommendation after seeing Mr. McDermott.
