## MESSAGE

As I mentioned by telephone conversation, Wilf McKinnon has returned to Flin Flon for a visit after a two year trip in the Yukon. His mailing address is Teslin, Yukon.

He has been prospecting on his own in the vicinity of the Alaska Highway, working mostly above timber line. As you know in the past he prospected for Hudson Bay Exploration & Development in the Yukon and in British Columbia for five years, and he has a good working knowledge of what new areas should be prospected.

During the last two years of prospecting on his own expenses, he has come across a large quartzite body containing disseminated chalcopyrite over large areas in the quartzite. He found intrusive diorite dykes into this quartzite containing disseminated chalcopyrite and feels this area needs prospecting in a more detailed way, ~~since~~ since he just located this find late last fall. <sup>#</sup> He has another spot where Hudson Bay Exploration a few years ago, had a copper and zinc find. They had done a survey and tried to get a hole into the showing, but a field of boulders prevented them from doing this. They then moved to another location near the find and drilled an anomaly which gave them graphite, after which they quit the field. Wilf says there is a good location for a drill hole further up the mountain on the zinc-copper showing. He also says that he returned to this spot and put down some trenches through the overburden to the showing. He has three trenches exposing the showing for 700 feet in length and 12 feet in width, which gave copper and zinc mineralization; but there are parallel stringers of zinc with disseminated values for 50 feet in width exposed in one place. He feels that he could bring a bulldozer to this location, and, within a month's time, properly


