Dear Mr. Gosselin:

I must apologize for the delay in re-contacting you with reference to your letter of November 17, 1972, regarding your property on which you have indications of nickel.

We have had some experience with nickel prospects in the Cordilleran area, and frankly feel that in this region we are better advised to emphasize exploration for other metals and minerals. Consequently we prefer to decline examination of this property.

I am sure that you will appreciate that in making this decision we are doing so in the best interests of all concerned. As you know, mines are not made without a certain measure of enthusiasm, and it would be best if others more favourably impressed with the nickel potential of the area were contacted.

Incidentally, we would be pleased to consider and possibly evaluate properties and prospects in which other metals are in evidence, and hope that you will keep us in mind in this regard. In the meantime, many thanks for your letter, and best wishes for 1973.






I am a Yukon prospector and am sending you some samples which have been assayed for nickel.
