Harry Fromme submitted this property on May 28th.

Yukon Revenue Mines is an active exploration organization based in Whitehorse. It is headed up by Harry Fromme and Harry Johannes. They have a number of properties in the Yukon but are trying to divest themselves of a property 45 miles west of Carmacks which is currently described by Doug Campbell as being a porphyry copper type.

The history of this property to the extent that I know it is as follows:

- 1951 - Conwest conducted EM and resistivity surveys
- 1952 - Teck Corporation drilled 5 holes in breccia pipe
- 1959 - Asbestos Corporation conducted soil and silt surveys
- 1964 - Canex drilled 4 holes
- 1968 - Yukon Revenue Mines conducted I.P. survey and drilled 5 holes.
- 1969 - Doug Campbell recommends 9,000 feet of diamond drilling for a total cost of \$200,000.

Neither the breccia pipe nor the pyritic halo surrounding the pipe appear to have economic values in copper. The drilling would therefore have to be done in the intermediate zone between the two. I seriously question the need for this amount of drilling to determine whether or not significant values occur. Actually, one hole has already been drilled in the intermediate zone which presumably was a dud. I have told Harry Fromme that I would visit the property when I go to see Fred. All I can say however, is that I am not very optimistic about the outcome.
