Gordon Dickson 48-Claim Silver Property,
Southeast Yukon

The attached data refer to a situation which Al Kulan phoned me about on Monday.

He reported that Gordon Dickson had just returned from staking a 48 claim group some 10 miles southeast of Conwest's new important silver property in the southeast Yukon. The known showings on Dickson's ground had been found and investigated some 5 of 6 years ago by an Einar Hagen, an elderly prospector whom I think worked this summer for Jim Harquail's Nahanni Syndicate. Hagen had let the ground lapse some 4 or 5 years ago. Dickson wanted \$200.00 per claim (\$9,800) cash down, \$25,000 in March, 1964 and 150,000 shares in a company of any size.

I asked Kulan to assay the grab samples Dickson had brought back, and to let me know the silver-lead ratio results.

He wired this morning that the ratios were very low. Because of that and because the showings are not new, I wired Kulan to take no further interest until at least next summer, and I followed up my wire with a memorandum adding that if Dickson has not dealt the ground before then that Al should ask permission to examine it then.

Subject Gordon Dickson 48 Claim Silver property, Southeast Yukon Date October 4, 1961

I have just received your wire and have sent one in return.

My reason for advising you to take no further interest in the property at least until next summer is prompted by the very low silver to lead ratio which you report from the assays, and by the fact that the showings known on the property have been previously worked and then abandoned. Those considerations argue against the paying out of approximately \$10,000 cash at this time to acquire the property.

If by the start of next year's field season Gordon Dickson has not dealt out the property I think it would be worthwhile for you to ask him for permission to have a good look at it. You would be able to make a much better examination of the property than you would be able to now almost at the end of this year's field season when winter might descend on you at any time.

I appreciate very much your promptness in telling me about this situation.
