*Prospecting in
Watson Lake
area for the
summer.*

I received a call from Andy Jenson of Kenora, Ontario who is backed by a group of Kenora business men headed by Jack Edwards and Bob Young. Andy called from Watson Lake, B.C. from the Venture Hotel on Sunday night.

He is prospecting at Watson Lake and turned up a high grade placer deposit of gold and platinum near Watson Lake and he is presently planning on moving a bulldozer in to do some stripping. Mr. Young, a business man from Kenora, is leaving here to go to the property and will be dropping in to see Bill Sirola at our Vancouver office. I believe we may have first opportunity if they come up with something interesting.

However, the reason for Andy's call was to turn me over to the owner of the Venture Hotel, Mr. Jake Melynchuk whose phone number at Watson Lake is 536-7473. Mr. Melynchuk is in with a group of prospectors who have formed a company named Winko Mines that have come up with several properties that have interesting showings on them. One property he says occurs in limestone about 40 miles from Watson Lake. It is in a bed that averages about 7½ feet wide containing copper+bornite and can be traced for 4000 ft. An average sample runs 3.4% copper for 7.7 feet and dips into the hill at about 60°. They also have another property that has massive galena across 30 to 40 feet and runs for 1200 feet in length. He has come across an area that he is now trying to open up with trenching that has a large area of numerous veins and veinlets carrying high grade silver and they have a fourth property that is an asbestos showing.

Mr. Melynchuk would be interested in having us look into the Winko Mines group and his own property as soon as possible, and at the same time if we went to visit the Jensen property, he will know where Andy is in the bush so that our representative can drop in to see the new find that Andy is opening up.

They would like to know if we are going to visit their property in the near future and if not they would like to be advised so they can approach some other companies.
