 Subject Ed Greer Base Metal Prospect, Frances River Area, Yukon. (105/H). Date September 8th, 1965

I have forgotten to mention to you that when I was in your office on Friday, August 20th a prospector Ed Greer came in submitting a base metal prospect on which he had recently staked 16 claims. The general location of the prospect is circled in red on the attached map which I obtained from your office. Greer said the showings occur over a 2000 foot length, and are from 1" to 17' in width.

Greer said he had first found the mineralization in 1962 while prospecting independently. He admitted that it has been seen by a Norquest Syndicate geologist whom he said was too inexperienced to recognize its potential. Greer quoted the following assay results from samples he had taken in July this year; he wasn't very clear on what type of samples they were, and I concluded that they probably were at least biased random chip samples:

I asked him for time to ask Lew Green in Whitehorse what he knew. On the flight to Whitehorse the next day I had a chat with Lew at the Watson Lake airport. He knew very little of the area other than it is known to contain gneissic intrusions.

After further thought, and influenced by our lack of available examining geologists and the fact that at least one geologist had seen the prospect a few years ago and was apparently not impressed, I wired Greer the following message at the Parkway Hotel in Vancouver on August 23rd: "Regret not able to take any interest in your property at this time".
