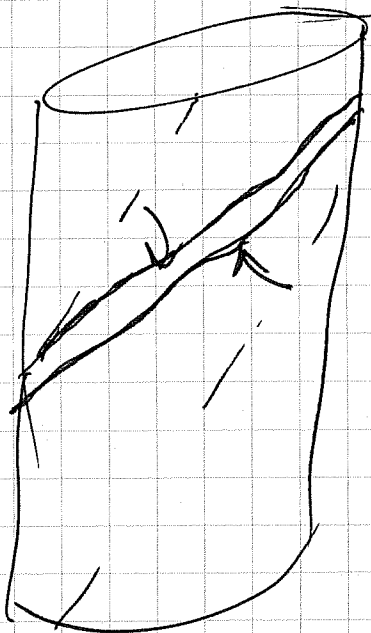
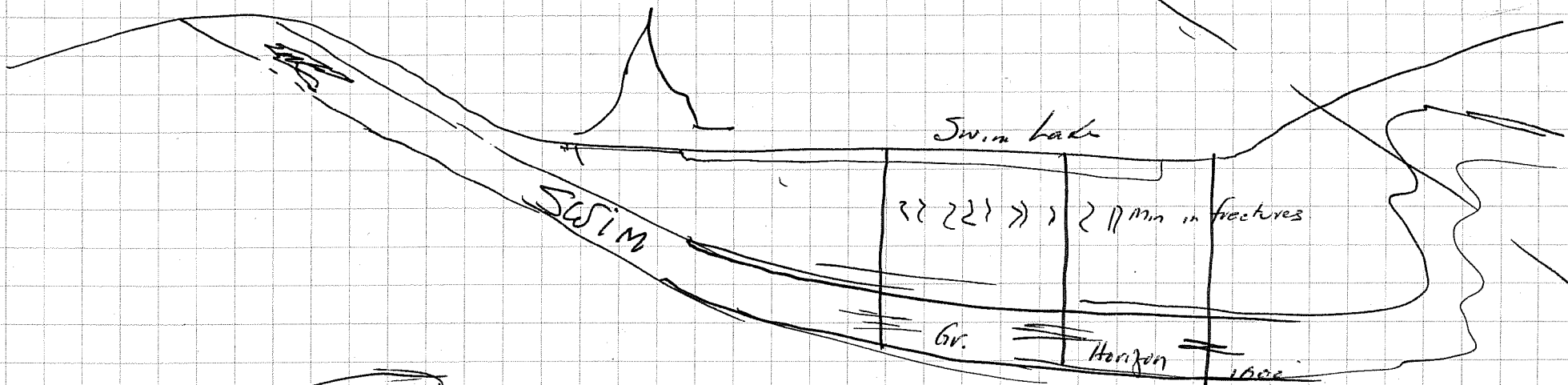

① D.J. thinks Swin graphite horizon can be traced to area of Spring L. on Vangorda, i.e., Swin would be stratigraphically above Vangorda.

② Vangorda is on crest of doubly plunging fold.

③ New Anal Hole adjacent to Mac 142 m.c.s on Vangorda found Sulphides @ 2000 down plunge Graphite horizon in that hole is down plunge from graphite mapped on surface S.E. of Vangorda deposit.

④ Metamorphic grade increases stratigraphically downwards from NW to S.E. rather than Northwestward from
