Crone does detect some evidence of weak EM anomalous conditions from the EM data you submitted, and occurring roughly between lines 52 and 68, ie over roughly the same ground which you state in your October 21st memorandum you remember the weak ground magnetic indications to occur.

Crone gives only very low priority to the weak EM conditions, and considers that they should only be tested by drilling if drilling of the B and C anomalies on the BC Group gave encouraging results. Otherwise he would be inclined to recommend that no further attention be paid to the D Group.

I am awaiting Dave's ground magnetic map of the D Group from you.



The enclosed map has one line of geochemical samples shown in red ink. This line indicates that there at least weak geochemical indications coinciding with the magnetic high between Line 60 and 68 S. at the Base Line.

If we are going to drill the "C" group, it would be wise to do more geochemical work over the other magnetic highs on this group.

My only justification for suggesting gravity work on the "D" Group is that our knowledge of this group is, in my view, inadequate. Secondly, since we are having to pay to hold the ground, I think it better to derive some information for the money expended. I concede that the possibilities here are not as good as on the "BC" Group because of the absence of graphitic schist.

This small 1966 gravity survey is budgeted for & will be carried out.
