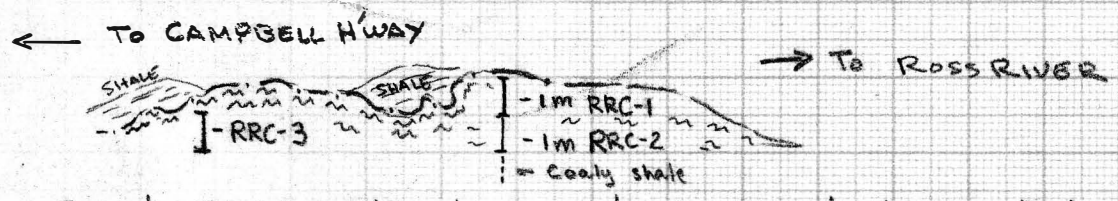

1) VERTICAL CHANNEL SAMPLES ALONG ROAD CUT



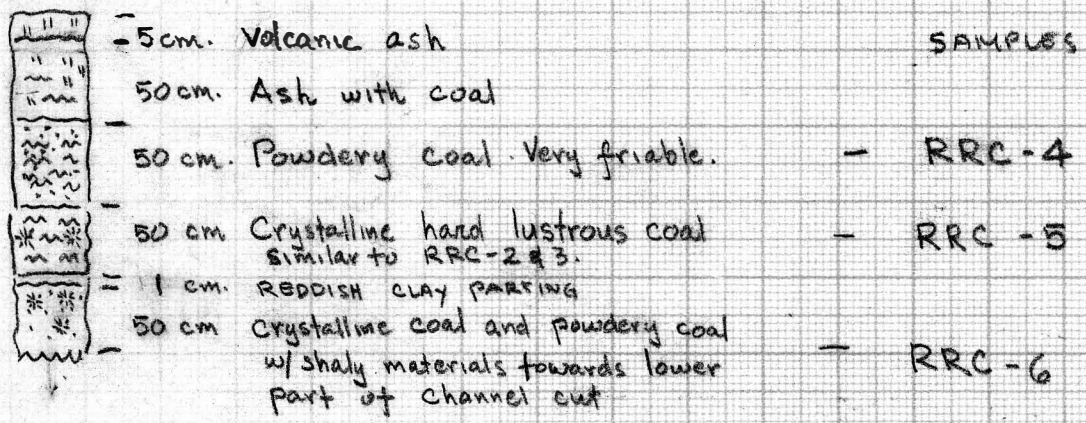
Sample RRC-1 - Black, hard coal w/resinous luster. Nearly horizontal bedding
 shallow dipping eastward

RRC-2 - More crystalline and harder than RRC-1. Same resinous luster.
 Underlain by coaly shale.

RRC-3 - Similar to RRC-2. Has 2 cm thick reddish clay parting.

2) VERTICAL CHANNEL SAMPLES ALONG BULLDOZER TRENCH

Approx 150 m southward of roadcut exposure and 50m upslope from road.
