We have reliable information that Conwest has a new silver find some 24 miles west of its recent copper find in the Yukon.

Because the copper find is located at approximately 61° 20' N, 130° 45' W this means that the new silver find is in the general Ketzka River area in which high grade silver occurrences have been found in the past. None of them have proven to be of sufficiently large tonnage.

Samples from the new find are reported to have assayed 50 to 350 ozs. in silver, and ~~that~~ tetrahedrite is present. The mineralization is reported to have been observed over a 4000 foot length; no widths have been mentioned. The above length is usually long for the area but it may not represent one continuous zone.

This situation points up the need for us to have arrangements with other persons in the Yukon and in British Columbia who will report things they hear quickly and who will be able to act quickly for us. The consideration of, and the setting up of, such contacts will be one of the main purposes of my trip west early next month, and I wish that you would give considerable thought to the matter before I arrive.
