Dear Al: Re. Ross River District, Yukon

I have a note in front of me reminding me to write to you asking about what, if anything, turned out from the following reported occurrences you mentioned to me when I was in the Yukon in June:

- (1) The Jack LaDue bornite and galena southeast of Ross River *probably not worth looking at*
- (2) The Rose Olie copper - series of 9 1/2 stringers in a chert northeast of Ross River *- no good.*
- (3) The Jack LaDue copper and magnetite east of Little Salmon *- a sp. of little gossans - e. of Little Salmon + n. of Maguandy R.*

I would appreciate it if you would let me know of anything that has happened regarding those three situations.

It may be that I will be making a trip into the Yukon with Bill Sirola sometime this month, or possibly in September. In the meantime, best of luck and I hope that your family will have a successful move into Vancouver.
