

A few days ago, Ken Thompson advised me that he had been talking in Whitehorse with Jack McTague of Boyles Brothers. McTague told him that he felt the expediting for the Boyles crew at Swim Lakes should be our responsibility. It is Ken's view that should he be asked to do this additional work, he should receive more money for his services.

Before getting into any meaty discussions with Mr. McTague on this matter, I felt that I should express my opinions to you. I do not feel there is anything in the contract which obligates us to any expediting for Boyles Brothers and I consequently disagree with Mr. McTague. I think any increase to Ken Thompson should be paid for by Boyles Brothers. The amount of the increase would be a function of how much running around Ken would have to do. If it is simply a matter of submitting a weekly grocery order to the Whitehorse suppliers then I think that no increase is in order. If however, it becomes a time consuming situation for Ken, then he should definitely be paid for his time. I would like to see what happens in the first month of operation before agreeing to anything. At that time we would be better equipped to discuss the matter with both Mr. Thompson and Mr. McTague.
