Dear Ted:

Re Sid Wright's Chataway Lake property: radio-comm. is out between Kamloops and Chataway Lake- has been since I got in Friday night. However, Mr Jim Marshall, PWA, Kamloops, is fairly sure Wright is at Chataway Lake, so: plan to go Kamloops tonite and fly in to Chataway Lake Tuesday. Will be out from Chataway by Thursday, and probably go to Penticton and see Albert Boy on Friday. Talked to Coy on the phone this morning. He says he has samples of the nickel-bearing rock from their claims Camp McKinney, at Penticton. He does not have any assays of samples taken, but has one 0.05% taken by the original claim owner who brought the property to him. Will be guided by your advice re getting terms before looking at the showing.

Re Kulan prospecting venture: I completed a formal prospecting agreement with Kulan at Watson Lake-(found I had two blank copies of the standard agreement form in the Whse files), and mailed them to you at Watson L. Change clause 8 as per your letter. Al understands the programme is confined to two months and as you point out, beyond the end of September, not much prospecting can be done in the Pelly area.

Kulan should be out of Whitehorse today: the plan is to visit him (me) at Grayling Lake on the 10th August, or if Asbestos Corp have their helicopter in the Canal area, Robinson may visit him prior to that date. It is my understanding with Al though, that, I supervise the programme and there is no allowance for copter flights to visit the area. I'll see Robinson next week at Whse and confirm that we are supervising the programme.

Kulan is not taking a partner with him on this trip. The only equipment we had to buy was a set of cooking pots. Al is taking one of our old tents in and will not likely bring it out.

He may need the use of a boat and motor on the Pelly late in September and if so can use P.A. flat-bottomed boat which has been used this season by Dept of Public works, in connection with surveys of the Carmacks- Little Salmon- Ross River rd. Cecil McClellan, recovered the bottom of the boat and once he is finished the Ross Magundy section of the survey, will leave it available for Al. The motor- I have in storage at Whse

Dear Ted:

Visited Kulan today and Robinson, Kulan, and self had a discussion last night (10th) at Lapie Lake. The code name for accounting for this job is 'Robbie'. Robinson has acknowledged, without argument, that P.A. directs the venture. He has a very handy vehicle, namely, a G-2 Bell helicopter, at his beck and call and his attitude, for your information, is "go ahead and use it". In spite of the fact, I have an affectionate interest in these instruments, have made it clear, our budget on this job will not stand such expensive luxuries, and any "go ahead and use it" uses, will be strictly, buckshee trips.. Got bawled out by Al's wife for not bringing a letter back from him. The bastard didn't write one and she is pregnant: I sure as the dickens get involved in odd deals in this exploration here.

Lou Green gave us the tip on the copper float and gave Robinson a pinpoint location, a few days ago when he dropped into their Lapie Lake Camp. It would be wise not to advertise this fact since Jim Roddick's nose is out of joint and he just isn't saying what-if anything- his part of Operation Pelly has seen in the way of mineralization.

I sent you a summary of the discussion with Johnson by mail Sunday nite. Had your wires this morning and tried to catch you at the office this afternoon. Have arranged to call you ten AM the 12th at the office.

### Misc:

Ivor sold Conwest two outboards. I'll invoice them from here, and ask them to pay by cheque to Toronto. The same as for the tent I sold to Canol Metal Mines.

Frankie Slim went to pick up the balance of the casing and pipe at Blind Creek: could not find any of it: reports heavy erosion of the banks of the Pelly. The river is at a record high for August. I'll check this development later when Kulan is prospecting in the Pelly area.

That was a H. of a visit I had with my family with the work I had to complete. I'm not kicking, actually, but J.O. the two-year old, wanted to know why, not if, I was staying overnight....
